1. Vote on letter to the CDC in support of DES's grant application – Upon motion by Corwin, seconded by Pohli, membership voted (via email) to support signing on to a letter in support of DES's grant application "to fund a Private Well Program Coordinator at DES to work full-time on increasing testing and treatment of private well water in New Hampshire to reduce chronic exposure to arsenic or other common contaminants and reduce potential associated health impacts. Currently, no position as DES formally is dedicated to support private well testing and treatment efforts. This new position would expand the state's capacity to support local efforts to increase testing and treatment. ...46% of NH residents rely upon private wells as a primary source of drinking water and many are vulnerable to exposure to elevated levels of harmful contaminants in groundwater, like arsenic." Vote in favor: All in favor. Rigrod abstained from voting.
